### Remembrance Service



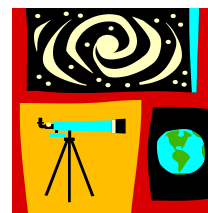
The school held a Remembrance Service today to mark our respects for past and present soldiers and their families. All monies raised from donations for poppies will go to the British Legion.

### Oliver Twist

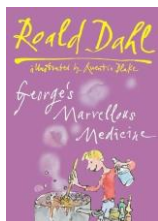
On Thursday next week our Year 6 class are going to the Brindley Theatre to watch Oliver. We hope they have a wonderful time and that this supports their learning in class.
