READING!

- ⦿ Children need to read every night.
- ⦿ Doesn't require adult supervision.
- ⦿ Need to ensure they have their reading book in school every single day.
- ⦿ Helps to expand vocabulary and develop the children's imagination.

INFORMATION STATION!

- ◉ Daily talk with the children about current affairs issues.
- ◉ Huge emphasis on people, places and politics.
- ◉ Our aim is to give children a greater understanding of the world around them.
- ◉ Make them active participants within democracy.

Talking!

- ⦿ Homework club Fridays






