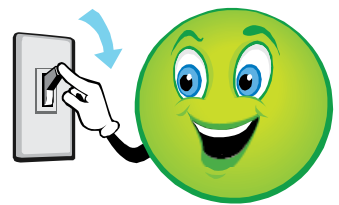

Olivia; Dalayo; Daniel; Elle; Georgia; Jack; Billy; Faye; Erin; Alex; Brody and David.

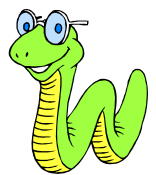
### Visit to Gillmoss
