### St Albert's Mass

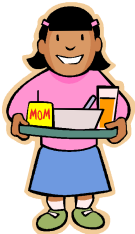

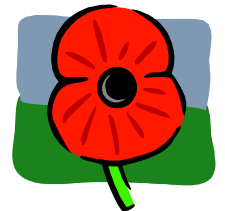
### School Meal – Bands System
