We have some meetings planned for parents to join in with to inform you of different systems we are using in school.

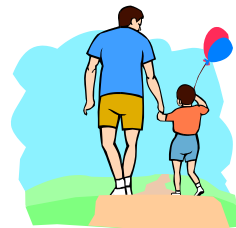

Please put these dates in your diary and join us in school for more information.

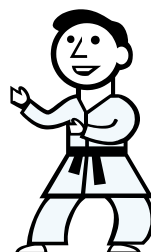
Welcome to our Dads
