

## Strike Action

As you will be aware, the combined teacher and support staff trade unions will be taking industrial action on the 10<sup>th</sup> July 2014.

The action (a one day strike) will result in class or whole school closures across the country.

The decision to close the school or send pupils home is never taken lightly, but in this instance, where staff have elected to take lawful industrial action, I will have no choice but to take appropriate steps to ensure the health, safety and wellbeing of all pupils.

We are aware that class/school closures inconvenience parents and carers and so I am writing to give you advance notice of the likely impact of the action on this school.

If the action goes ahead, the following arrangements will be in place:

- School will be **CLOSED** to pupils

The school will re-open as normal on Friday 11th July.
