Nursery Playground Update

The nursery playground development is scheduled to begin next week and will probably take 3 weeks to complete. Whilst the work is underway, we ask that parents bring their children to nursery via the entrance to Alby Tots which is on the Haswell Drive side of school and not through the main entrance off Steers Croft. The children will enter through the side door to Nursery. Due to lack of space and safety we would ask parents to drop their children off and not enter the school. This will be an opportunity for us to encourage the children to be more independent. When the children return from the Christmas holidays they will have full access through the normal entrance. We will see how practical this arrangement is, and if necessary make alternative arrangements.
