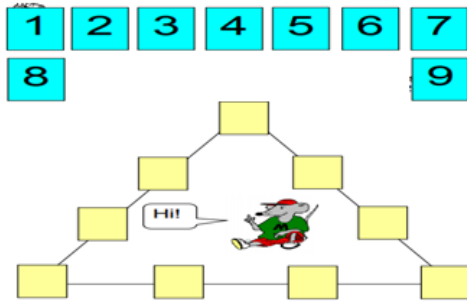




Maths Corner
