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Health and Fitness

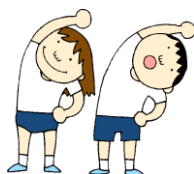

Thank you to all the parents who attended our parents meetings this week. Your child's report will be sent out at the end of term.

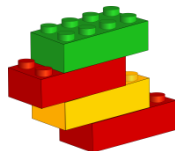
Goodbye Mrs Edwards
