Chronological order	In the order that it happened.
Past	Gone by in time, no longer existing.
Present	Existing now
Similarities	The same, or almost the same.
Differences	The way in which 2 or more things are not the same
Before	In the past A time earlier than....
After	The time following an event/ period of time.
A long time ago	Far in the past, not at all recent.
Past	Gone by in time.
Physical features	Naturally created features/ objects.
Human features	Things that are built by humans.

1. Kitty Wilkinson was responsible for the first wash house in Liverpool.
 2. Joseph Wilkinson employed men to dig tunnels during a time of high unemployment.
 3. Stockbridge Village was built in the 60s to re house 15,000 people from the inner city Liverpool.
 4. The first house was ready in 1965 but there were few facilities.
 5. In 1968 St Albert's Primary School opened.
