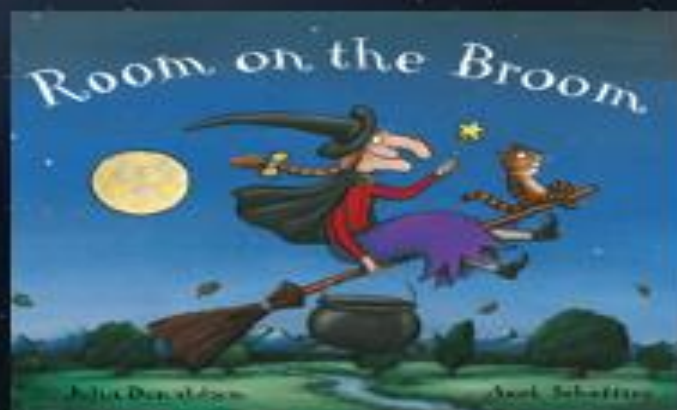




Reception: Room on the Broom Autumn!



PSED:

- The witch was thankful- what are we thankful for? Discuss and share ideas (Link to harvest festival - giving thanks).
- Talk about how the characters feel
- Use carpet to take turns in sharing thoughts and ideas (encourage turn taking)

Communication and Language:

- Encourage children to listen to the story with increasing attention and recall
- Discuss aspects of the story - how/why questions
- Look at the rhyming words in the story
- Play games: Silly soup

Physical development:

- Begin to form recognisable letters
- Copy some letters from name/write own name
- Begin to show some control in holding/using mark making tools

Literacy:

- RWInc -
- Listen to stories with increasing attention and recall
- Recognise rhythm in spoken words
- Talk about the setting/characters in stories
- Name writing

Understanding the world:

- Harvest Festival: talk/discuss harvest, what happens at this time? Visit allotments to look for signs of Autumn and see food that has grown

Expressive Arts and Design:

- Encourage children to go on an Autumn walk: collect leaves/conkers/pine cones for our Autumn table
- Make Autumn collages
- Opportunities for Leaf printing
- Describe textures of collected items

- Autumn: conkers, acorn, leaves
