

























Essential Characteristics of Reading:

- Well-organised and structured writing which includes a variety of sentence structures
- Excellent transcription skills that ensure their writing is well presented and punctuated, spelled correctly and neat
- A love of writing and an appreciation of its educational, cultural and entertainment values

- A rich and varied vocabulary that gives clarity and interest to conversations
