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Gates - 5 to 9

All gates will be closed promptly at 8.55am. If the gates are closed and staff are still about, they will be directing lates to the front gate. Please try and set off a couple of minutes earlier to avoid this inconvenience.

Lates

Thank you to the huge amount of families who are getting their children into school on time. It makes a huge difference to your child and how they start their day off. If they come into school on time they are prepared and not playing catch up or getting embarrassed.

If your child is late they need to enter via the Steercroft front entrance. Parents must bring the children to the office and sign them in. Please do not drop the children at the gates if late as this is a Health and Safety issue.

Unfortunately, we had 14% of the children late today and this is concerning. We appreciate, however that parents are getting used to the new regime on the gates so hopefully this number, with your co-operation, will be drastically reduced next week.

Early collection of children

Please be aware that children must be collected at the end of the school day - 3.15pm from their class door. Children can only be collected earlier than this when they have a pre-arranged appointment.
