Admissions

You will be aware that the closing date for Reception 2022 admissions is this coming Saturday 15th January. If you have not yet applied for a place please call into the school office ASAP. If you have applied and your child is baptised please bring their baptism certificate in to school.

School Uniform

Full school uniform is essential and children should not be coming into school in anything other than the school PE kit or the school uniform. We have a number of children coming into school in various coloured items and this is not allowed. Likewise, the school uniform stresses sensible black shoes and whilst we may turn an eye to a sensible black trainer, many children are coming into school in inappropriate (and expensive) coloured trainers. I would ask that you purchase a relatively cheap pair of school shoes rather than expensive trainers that are not appropriate for school. It is important that all of our children look smart and follow the school rules.
