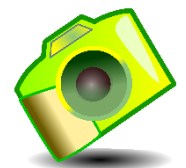


Y5 Trip to Anfield

If you would still like to purchase your child's school photograph the photographer has informed us that you will have until Tuesday 18th April to get your orders into school. Alternatively you can order online at any time.

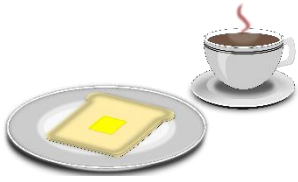
