Reading

- Children **need** to read every day.
- It requires some adult supervision.
- Need to ensure they have their reading book in school every single day.
- Helps to expand vocabulary and develop the children's imagination.
- Reading is a gift.

Information Station

- Daily talk with the children about current affairs issues.
- Huge emphasis on people, places and politics.
- Our aim is to give children a greater understanding of the world around them.
- Make them active participants within democracy.

Talking

- Huge emphasis on talking to help develop writing.
- If children can't describe their story out loud then they'll struggle to express it in their writing.
- Children to develop their speaking skills in general.
- Being able to talk confidently in front of large groups of people is a huge skill, and is one we're looking to develop.

Power Maths



Power Maths is a whole-class mastery programme designed to spark curiosity and excitement and help you nurture confidence in maths. At the heart of Power Maths is the belief that all children can achieve. It's built around a child-centred lesson design that models and embeds a growth mindset approach to maths.



Year 3 maths

- Maths within the current framework focuses on three key principles.
- FLUENCY PROBLEM SOLVING REASONING
- During the Autumn term we will be focusing heavily on place value, and addition and subtraction.
- Power Maths - More talk and manipulatives

English

- Started off with Here we are & The Tin Forest
- All our English work will be based around a book.
- Read it week - Write it Week
- Big emphasis on spellings
- Handwriting and neat presentation

Foundation subjects

- History, Geography, Science, Art, DT, RE, PHSE, Music, Computing
- Main thing is to be curious - encourage your ch to be curious about the world - why do things happen - why does rain fall? How do volcanoes work? Why do we have a shadow?
- Geography - Liverpool's local geography.
- Science - light and dark
- Art - drawing still life
