Physical development:

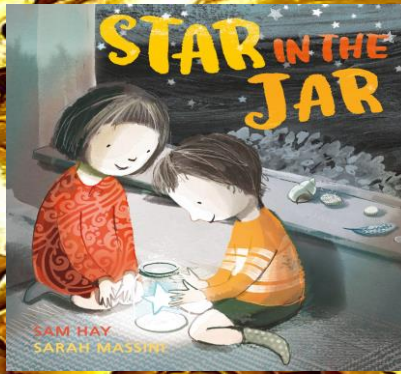
- Modelling how to use and hold a pencil correctly
