MMR Vaccinations

There are concerns about a potential measles outbreak in Knowsley. As we live in a community where the number of unvaccinated children is very high. There is a call to encourage families to vaccinate their children as soon as possible. There will be a Livewell Bus in Stockbridge Village (Leach Croft) offering vaccinations on Thursday 14th March which is easily accessible. If there is an outbreak, unvaccinated children may be asked to isolate for 21 days and this would be a concern.

Voting in Knowsley

Elections will be taking place in Knowsley on <u>Thursday 2nd May 2024</u>. To vote you must be registered to vote by <u>Tuesday 16th April 2024</u>. If you've never registered, have moved address or changed your name, register to vote online at <u>www.gov.uk/register-to-vote</u>

Once you have registered, there is several different ways you can vote -

Postal Vote - If you are not already registered for a postal vote, you need to do so by 5pm on Wednesday 17th April 2024. You can apply online for a postal vote by visiting the Governments website and providing you National Insurance number. If you are already registered to vote, you don't need to do anything.

Voting in person at a Polling Station: If you are voting in person on Thursday 2nd May, please remember to bring a valid photo ID with you. If you don't have a valid ID, apply for a Voter Authority Certificate up until 5pm on Wednesday 24th April. Apply online on the Governments website. If you are unable to register to vote online, or need assistance in registering for a postal vote or Voter Authority Certificate please contact Knowsley's Elections team on 0151 443 2222 or by emailing elections@knowsley.gov.uk
