As we live in a community where the number of unvaccinated children is very high, there is a call to encourage families to vaccinate their children as soon as possible. There will be a Livewell Bus in Stockbridge Village (Leach Croft) offering vaccinations on **Thursday 14th March** which is easily accessible. If there is an outbreak, unvaccinated children may be asked to isolate for 21 days and this would be a concern.
