On **Friday 19<sup>th</sup> April** the Green Guardians Group have planned a Litter Pick involving our Year 6.

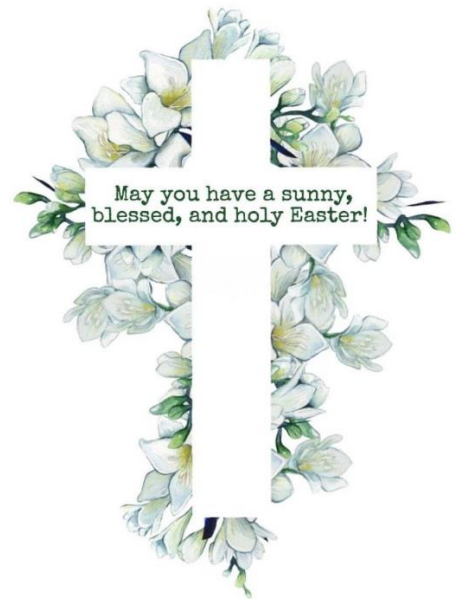
### Communion Dates
