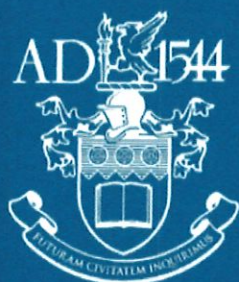
This evening is for parents of Year 6 boys who would like to view the school and join Cardinal Heenan Catholic High School in **SEPTEMBER 2026**.
