## Line

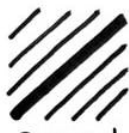
A single long mark made by an implement.

## Vocabulary

Spiral	a curve that starts at a fixed point and continues to go around and around.
Movement	change in position or location.
Pressure	a steady force upon a surface.
Motion	the process, manner, or continuous action of moving
Oil Pastel	An oil based crayon similar to chalk
Blending	to mix enough so that there no longer seem to be separate parts
Dark/Light	(Not) A pale colour
Mark Making	The creations of lines, dots and patterns on a surface
Sketchbook	a book or pad of drawing paper for making sketches
Observation	Noticing the environment through use of the senses.
