VOCABULARY

Primary colours	The basic colours that cannot be made by mixing other colours.
Secondary colours	Colours created by mixing two primary colours together.
Monochromatic	Using one colour, with different shades, tints, and tones of that colour.
Pattern	A repeated design or shape.
Proportion	The size relationship between different parts of a work. It shows how big or small one part is compared to another.
Croquis	A stylized, elongated human figure sketch (usually 9 heads tall) used as a base to quickly draw and visualize clothing designs.
Geometric	Shapes, patterns, or designs that are based on geometry.
Contrast	The arrangement of opposing elements—like light/dark, smooth/rough, warm/cool colours—to create visual interest.
Tones	Variations in lightness/darkness.

Yves Saint Laurent



Yves Saint Laurent was a famous French fashion designer who helped change modern fashion. He was born in 1936 and became well known for creating stylish but practical clothes, including the first tuxedo suit for women. He founded the Yves Saint Laurent (YSL) brand and made high-quality fashion more accessible to everyday people.
