Security On Gates

We have robust security of gates in place but due to some issues in other schools these will be tightened up.

Only Nursery children to enter via the Nursery Gate.

Gates will close at 8.55am prompt. If closed, parents need to enter via the school office and sign children in.

Likewise, if parents miss the closure of the gate they will need to exit via the front gates.

Children to be encouraged to enter on their own to limit number of adults in school.

Home time Security

Reminder that the school gates only open at 3.10pm and if parents are early, they may be asked to wait.

The office will only man the gate from **2.45pm** for parents collecting children if they have evidence of an appointment (they may lose their pm mark if continually collected early). Staff need to be in the office for security reason not collecting children for parents early. We are no longer able to manage parents collecting children early.

Reception

We are now encouraging Reception parents to leave their children at the gate if they enter via Haswell Drive. A member of staff will support. This encourages independence and prepares them for Y1 when they should enter independently. Mrs Fleming is working on this with the children.


