Y4 First Holy Communion

Please ensure that all your guests (who may be unfamiliar with church) are aware that it is a place of worship and they need to be quiet throughout the service. We wish you all a happy and holy day and hopefully the sun will be shining.

Year 6 SATS

Our Year 6 children will be starting their SATS on **Monday 11th May**. To ensure they are given every possible opportunity to achieve their best, it's important that children attend school every day, arrive on time and are well rested. To support children during SAT's, they are invited into school at 8am Monday-Thursday for a special breakfast. We would encourage all children to attend this as it will help settle any nerves and ensure the children are alert and focused to do their best!

Lates for SATs Week

Next week is SATs week, and to maintain a calm and quiet environment for pupils taking their tests, any children arriving after 8:55am (when the school gate closes) will not be able to enter through the hall as this may cause disruption. Late arrivals must report to the school office to be registered and order their dinner, and parents/carers will need to accompany them to their classroom. We kindly ask that all children arrive on time and before 8:55am wherever possible.

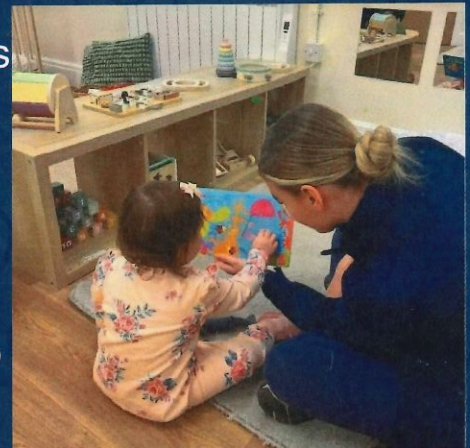

What the Offer Looks Like:

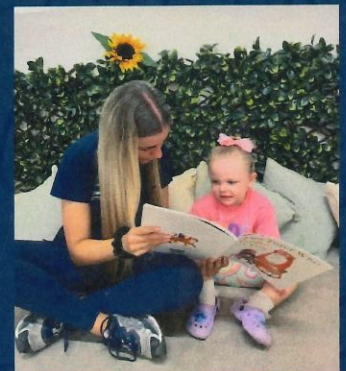
- **After School Club** (until 6:00pm) – £10 per session
